- To oversee and train for daily Pre-Task Hazard Analysis and Job Hazards Analysis
- To conduct accident/incident investigation to determine cause and corrective action
- To enforce CCE Hot Work Policy and Lock Out/Tag Out (LOTO) policies and procedures
