SUMMARY OF ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Disassembles, cleans, repairs, or replaces light fixtures; replaces light bulbs, ballasts and sockets on lighting systems 300 volts or less as part of a preventive maintenance lighting program for all Port Aviation Facilities.
- Responds to ad hoc requests for bulb replacement.
- Repairs or replaces broken or damaged lighting switches or controls, 300 volts or less.
- Constructs scaffolding to access areas that will not accommodate a lift.
- Keeps assigned vehicle clean and fueled.
- In an emergency may assist electricians with airfield lighting work, and routine tasks, including moving conduit, carrying cable, duct work or piping, and lifting manhole covers; receive pay commensurate with labor contract language.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- High school diploma or equivalent is required.
- Oregon Limited Building Maintenance (BME) is required. Oregon Journeyman Electrical license is preferred.
- Experience working in an industrial setting is desirable.
- Basic computer skills are required.
- Must possess and maintain a valid driver license at time of hire.
- Class B Commercial Driver License (CDL) at time of hire, or the ability to obtain within the probationary period is required.
- Ability to obtain and maintain eligibility for unescorted access to secure areas of the airport is required.
