

RECIPROCATATE OREGON TO IDAHO

1. First, you will need a “License Verification Request Form.” You can find the link here: <https://www.oregon.gov/bcd/Formslibrary/6065.pdf>
2. The form online is fillable. Fill out the form and save the form to your computer. There is an email address on the form and it will take anywhere from 2-6 weeks to get the form back.
3. Once you have the completed form (BCD will email it back to you) You have 2 options. 1) you can create an account online at D.O.P.L. which is the Division of Occupational and Professional Licenses with the State of Idaho – or 2) Take the completed form with you when you go to Idaho to sign the book and do your business over the counter.
4. If you choose the apply online – You are reciprocating your license. You will attach the completed form you received from the State of Oregon to your application, submitting \$70.00. You will receive your license number online.
